

## These easy maintenance procedures will give you years of great grassing!

1. Occasional brushing with a stiff broom (against the grain) will give grass a fresh cut look.
2. Pet mess can be picked up and easily washed with a garden hose (pick up after pets daily).
3. A yard blower or rake will help to keep debris off grass. A garden hose spray can also be used to wash off leaves and garden debris.
4. Spills can be cleaned up by using paper towels or a damp cloth. Clean with a mild detergent and irrigate with water. Dry with a clean towel or cloth. If infill is used it may need to be vacuumed up with a shop vac, then replace in after grass dries. **Note! Spills and solvents used for cleaning may void warranty.**
5. Infill, (*optional*), can be applied to top of grass with a drop spreader. Rubber Crumb is a choice of many grassing companies. It will help with keeping grass stable. Brush grass with a stiff broom against the grain after application.
